Class Specifications: All riders must be current WNEPHA Members

<u>Walk-Trot Final</u>: Open to Riders 12 and under who have qualified for this division by getting 28 points and have competed at 3 different barns in the qualifying year. Not allowed to compete in any other class or final at this show.

<u>Beginner Eq Final</u>: Open to riders who have qualified for this division by getting 28 points, have competed at 3 different barns in this qualifying year. Riders may not compete in any other class or final at this show.

<u>Short/Long Stirrup 18" Medal Final</u>: Open to riders who have qualified for this division by getting 10 points in the Medal class and have competed at 3 different barns in the qualifying year. Can not compete in any other final or class EXCEPT the 18" hunter classic (see qualification rules).

<u>Pre-Child/Adult 2' Medal Final</u>: Open to riders who have qualified for this division by getting 10 points in the Medal class and have competed at 3 different barns in the qualifying year. Can not compete in any other class EXCEPT for the 2' Hunter Classic (see qualification rules) and .65 Jumpers (see qualification rules)

<u>Children's Eq. 2'6 Medal Final:</u> Open to riders who have qualified for this division by getting 10 points in the Medal class and have competed at 3 different barns in the qualifying year. Can not compete in any other class EXCEPT the 2'6 Hunter Classic (see qualification rules) and the .75 Jumpers (see qualification rules)

Adult Eq. 2'6 Medal Final: Open to any Adult rider who has qualified for this division by getting 10 points in the Medal class and competed at 3 different barns in the qualifying year. Can not compete in any other Class except the Hunter Classic or Jumper Final (see qualification rules for those classes)

Modified Junior Eq 2'9 Medal Final: Open to any Junior rider that has qualified for this division by getting 10 points in the Medal class and has competed at 3 different barns throughout the qualifying year. Can not show in any other class except the Hunter Classic and jumper Final (see qualification rules for those classes)

Junior Eq. 3' Medal Final: Open to any Junior Rider that has qualified for this division by winning 10 points in the Medal class and has competed at 3 different barns throughout the qualifying year. Can not compete in any other class except the Hunter Classic or Jumper Final (see qualifications for those classes)

Hunter Classics (2 rounds- second round is Handy round, numerical scores, top 10 to ribbon, must have 3 to run)-Every rider must be

18" Hunter Classic: Open to any rider who has **never** competed over fences 18" or higher at a rated show. The Horse and the Rider must have competed at 3 different barns that were WNEPHA rated shows. Rider may **not** enter any other Hunter Classic at this show.

2' Hunter Classic: Open to any rider who has **never** shown over fences that are 2'6 or higher at a rated show or if the Horse is eligible for the baby Green Division in the WNEPHA. The Horse and the Rider must have competed at 3 different barns that were WNEPHA rated shows. Rider may **not** enter any other Hunter classic at this show.

2'6" Hunter Classic: Open to any rider who has **never** shown over fences that were over 3' at a rated show. The Horse and Rider must have competed at 3 different barns that were WNEPHA rated shows. Rider may **not** enter any other Hunter Classic at this show unless the Horse is eligible for Baby Green then the rider may show that horse in the 2' Classic.

<u>2'9ny28 Hunter Classic:</u> Open to any Horse and Rider that has competed in 3 different barns that were WNEPHA rated shows. Rider may not enter any other Hunter Classic at this show unless on a horse that is eligible for the Baby Green division then the rider may show that horse in the 2' Classic.

Jumpers: .65/.75/.90- Every rider must be a current WNEPHA member

Open to any rider that has qualified by competing at 3 different barns at WNEPHA rated show. No points needed. Must be eligible for the height that you do if you are competing in one of the medal final classes (see qualification and rules under the Medal final you are doing)

Horsemanship classes: Open to current Junior members of the WNEPHA who are qualified and competing at 2023 Finals at any level. The class will be judged and pinned as 2 separate classes based on show age of participant: 13 yrs. and under and 14-17(regardless of Medal final show level). There will be two portions to the score of each participant: the numerical score from the Equitation O/F class preceding the medal Final for which they have qualified and competing in and a written exam that will be administered Saturday and/or Sunday depending on which day the participant is showing. The questions will be from the US Pony Club D Manual for the 13/U and the USHJA Horsemanship study guide for the 14-17 yr olds. Must Pre-Enter. Winners will receive a \$250 Scholarship to be used toward instruction through a professional member of the WNEPHA. Will announce the winner before the start of the jumpers on Sunday (do not need to present to get your award)
